

Every Library in Michigan is eligible to select Digital Content at no cost

The Lakeland Library Cooperative is pleased to announce that the “MI-83 Digital Library Connection” will be used to support the priorities of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) by providing all Michigan public libraries with equitable, in-perpetuity access to digital content in ebook and audiobook format. Funding is provided in part by the Institute of Museum and Library Services through the Library of Michigan, an agency of the Michigan Department of Education. Project partners include the Michigan Library Cooperatives and the Michigan Library Association

This grant will provide digital content to individual libraries, Shared Content Groups, and libraries that have never been able to offer digital content to their communities, enabling all Michigan residents to benefit from these federal funds. Every legally established Michigan public library is eligible for digital content, even those that do not qualify for state aid.

In keeping with the federal legislative priorities, digital content topics will include mental health, workforce development, job seeking skills, health, and general educational needs with a focus on nonfiction titles to enhance current collections and create new ones.

FAQ: American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) MI-83 Digital Library Connection

What are ARPA Funds?

The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) designated \$200 million in pandemic response funding for the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS). These funds will enable IMLS to efficiently provide critical funding to State Library Administrative Agencies like the Library of Michigan (LM). Michigan’s total allotment was just over \$4 million.

What is the MI-83 Digital Library Connection Grant?

This grant will provide all residents in Michigan’s 83 counties access to equitable, in-perpetuity digital content in ebook and audiobook format. All legally established public libraries (don’t necessarily have to qualify for state aid) and tribal libraries that are open to the public will have the opportunity to participate and provide access to their patrons. The non-fiction materials will help all Michigan residents navigate our post-Covid future. The total amount awarded for content is over \$870,000.00. From where will the digital content be purchased?

The MI-83 Digital Library Connection committee has partnered with OverDrive to provide the platform and access to content for Michigan’s residents. OverDrive staff librarians will work closely with the Lakeland Library Cooperative, the grant administrator, to provide current curated lists for libraries and step-by-step instructions to make the process as smooth as possible. Each library will log into a separate ARPA MI 83 Overdrive account to make their purchases. Libraries will NOT use their individual Overdrive accounts. HOWEVER, if you overspend in your ARPA MI 83 account, you will be billed for the overage. Detailed information will follow.

What genres will be available for purchase?

The one-copy-one-user curated collection lists will focus on 17 genres including education, health, job-seeking skills, and workforce development. The cost of items will vary. The average cost of an ebook is \$25.77 and the average cost of an audiobook is \$52.21. Based on the amount of the grant designated for the digital content, over 25,000 in perpetuity items will be purchased by the end of September 2022 for Michigan residents.

How will Michigan residents learn about these new resources?

The Michigan Library Association (MLA) is a partner on this grant. A portion of the grant award will be used by MLA to create and execute a robust multimedia awareness campaign. This advertising campaign will be shared around the state informing patrons about the newly curated collections which will be available for download in their area. The marketing effort will include radio, tv, billboards, social media, and other outlets. Please be sure to let your patrons know how to access OverDrive content via computer or the [Libby App](#).

Not everyone belongs to an OverDrive Shared Content Group. How will this work?

The focus will be on three groups of libraries to provide digital access across the state:

1. Libraries that currently do not provide any access to OverDrive

Working with OverDrive, these libraries will be set up as a new Shared Content Group with the opportunity to join an established Shared Content Collection in the future.

3. Libraries that provide access to OverDrive but are not part of an Shared Content Group

These 11 standalone libraries have already been contacted and there is no need for these libraries to respond to this e-mail.

How do I find out how much money my library has been allocated?

A spreadsheet compiled with data provided by the Library of Michigan outlines each library’s allocation. Based on IMLS criteria, socioeconomic demographics including underserved populations, percentage of the population receiving supplemental nutrition assistance (SNAP), the poverty rate, unemployment, and access to broadband were the main factors used in determining the monetary portion for each participating library.

Now that I know how much my library has been allocated, what are the next steps?

Each library should complete this [survey](#) by 6:00pm on Monday, January 24. In it, you will indicate which one of three options your library will choose for their allocated funds:

- 1. Purchase content solely for their library using the full allocation.**
- 2. Allocate all their funds to their Shared Content Group.**
- 3. Split their allocated funds 50/50 with their Shared Content Group.**

The committee will review all responses to the survey and set up a schedule for libraries to begin purchasing materials. The funds will be rolled out in groups with dates and groups to be determined.

It is essential that deadlines are met and that purchases do not exceed the allocations provided. If there are funds remaining in an individual library's "account", they will be allocated to the library's Shared Content Group which will be the last group to purchase.

The committee encourages the use of "Advantage Plus," which allows others in a Shared Content Group to borrow materials that are not being requested by the local library's patrons.

What if I do nothing? What happens to the money allocated to my library?

If a library misses the deadline to respond to the survey, their funds will be allocated to their Shared Content Group. If the library is not part of a Shared Content Group, the funds will be given to the Shared Content Group affiliated with their cooperative.

The deadline is Monday, January 24, 2022, at 6:00 p.m.

All deadlines must be met due to the size and scope of this grant. All participants will be given additional detailed information no later than February 7, 2022, regarding separate ARPA account creation and training opportunities.
