- VII. ILS Manager report: Ann Langlois (ann@llcoop.org)
 - A. Inventory chugging along well
 - 1. One library completely done
 - 2. It is important to do this project
 - 3. Hoping for completion by March 2026
 - B. Patmos has reopened
 - 1. Ann trained their new hires
 - 2. They are moving books again
 - C. Should MeL be defunded, RIDES would not be included in that, so we should be able to get everything back to owning libraries
 - 1. We can provide information to patrons about this, but be careful not to 'lean' one way or another
- VIII. Ongoing Business:
 - A. Circ Policies Final Edits (These will still need to go to Advisory Council for approval)

- 1. CIRC 1.3 reciprocal borrowing is required, at least some part of your collection must be sharable
- 2. CIRC 2.5.4 Removed return anywhere restriction language
- 3. CIRC 2.3.2 Exception for juvenile registration
 - a) Lakeland is looking for help with the wording to cover what libraries are actually doing
 - (1) Differences for student cards mostly
 - b) Maybe remove 2.3.2 and just rely on Alternative Registration wording (2.4)
- 4. CIRC 2.5.2 does Mllibrary Card (Michicard) still exist?
- 5. CIRC 2.6 Cards are blocked at \$10.01
- 6. CIRC 2.11 Patrons do need separate records for different barcodes
- 7. CIRC 2.11.4 Property tax patrons expire every three years like regular cards
- 8. CIRC 3.4 If fees are waived by non-owning libraries, the owning library can reinstate those fees
- 9. CIRC 3.6 If library materials have a circ fee at the owning library, lending libraries may choose whether or not to collect those fees. If they collect those fees, they remain with the lending library.
- B. Registration Standards (Ask for examples from the person who suggested this)
 - 1. There was a question about the change from juvie to adult records, what is the specific issue?
 - 2. If you would like to review the policies, they are posted online (https://llcoop.org/ils-information/)
 - 3. If there is an ongoing issue, you can get Lakeland to help
 - 4. Lakeland can also help you run a report for accounts that need updating
- C. Home Library use
 - 1. Are libraries also changing the p-type to match the home library?
 - a) This must be done in order for holds to work
 - b) https://llcoop.org/wp-content/uploads/2023/08/Patron-registration-standards-for-Sierra-8-30.pdf
 - c) The home library determines where pick up happens, but the p-type determines what is holdable for that patron
 - d) Pat Agency and pcode4 are associated with where the patron pays taxes
 - 2. Patrons should not be allowed to change their home library daily to game the system
 - 3. Changing the home library should only be done to change pickup location
- D. How do you handle books and other items that are ruined by excessive cigarette or pot smoke?
 - 1. Cigarette smoke bins with kitty litter, baking soda, Arm and Hammer rocks (example), this library has had issues with pot smell sticking
 - 2. In a Ziploc back with unscented dryer sheets
 - 3. Totes with dryer sheets, wipe down with Clorox wipes

- E. PMESSAGES and MBLOCKS
 - 1. MBLOCKS cannot really be changed
 - 2. We can add another one or two PMESSAGES, if we all think there is a need
 - a) Like for hotspot agreements or agreement signed
 - (1) AV agreement signed change
 - b) Or record needs review or review patron record
 - c) Are we still using the RETURNED CHECK
